B. Chief's Report

Chief Lockhart discussed Department activity for July 2023. The list below highlights this month's Chief's Report (not in any particular order).

- Received \$36,940 for ARPA (American Rescue Plan) reimbursement on July 31. This claim required a great deal of paperwork and documentation. Staff spent at least 200 hours preparing this claim.
- Received a check in the amount of \$363.48 from FRUSA.
- Update on Steve McKinnon. Steve should return to work in mid September pending his doctor's approval.
- Update on new employee, Shane Brown. Shane Brown has been hired as a full time engineer, paramedic, firefighter. He is a former resident of the area and has extensive firefighter and forest service experience.
- CKFD has received millings from the county to improve the handicap ramp at the rear of the station. This work will proceed when Ryan Courtney returns from Wildland assignment.
- We will be receiving the final approval from GRIC to proceed with the new brush truck purchase on Sept. 2. Gila County resolution to accept these funds has passed. Chief Lockhart will begin purchase negotiations when he has more information about the designated process and time frame.
- Sterling White, Ryan Courtney, and two seasonals left for a wildland assignment in Texas on August 15. The assignment is for two weeks but may be extended to three weeks.

C. Chairman's Report & District Correspondence

Chairman Ron Kotnik wished the Doug Frenz family well as they pursue treatment for health issues.

BUSINESS

1. Discussion regarding a succession plan for hiring a new Fire Chief.

Chief Lockhart prepared a packet outlining the Board's responsibilities and possible steps in the process of searching for and hiring a new Fire Chief. The packet includes the current Chief's MOU and job description. Chief Lockhart has designated October 8 as his targeted retirement date. He is willing to work with the new Chief for up to 90 days or until February 20. After a good deal of discussion, the Board determined that this topic deserved a Special Board Meeting to devote enough time and discussion to these important issues. A Special Board Meeting will be held on Monday, August 28, 2023 at 3:30 to determine how we will proceed including the steps we need to take toward hiring a new Chief and the review of the current MOU and job description.

2. Discussion and signing of contracts from R-C Scout Ranch, Mountain Meadows Ranch, Tonto Creek Camp, and Tonto Rim Christian Camp.

Karen Thornton moved that the Board direct Chairman Ron Kotnik to sign all four contracts. Mark Hendrickson seconded the motion.



1. Discussion and possible action regarding a succession plan for hiring a new Fire Chief.

Chief Lockhart prepared a packet outlining the Board's responsibilities and possible steps in the process of searching for and hiring a new Fire Chief. The packet included the current Chief's MOU and a sample MOU written by an attorney. Chief Lockhart has designated October 8 as his targeted retirement date. Chief Lockhart is willing to work with the new Chief for up to 90 days or until February 20; however, he would prefer to be finished by January 19, 2024. The Board discussed the advantages of an internal vs. an external search. External searches can be expensive and lead to dealing with an unknown quantity. An internal search can be conducted by the local Board with little or no additional expense. The Board discussed the importance of an interview and background check. CKFD has the ability to run a background check for qualified candidates. Doug Frenz moved that The Board adopt a succession plan for hiring a new Fire Chief to include these steps: 1. Conduct an internal search, 2. Interview qualified candidates, 3. Conduct a background check on selected candidate. Mark Hendrickson seconded the motion.




