B. Chief's Report

Chief Lockhart discussed Department activity for December 2022. The list below highlights this month's Chief's Report (not in any particular order).

- Old Engine 511 waiting for valves to come in for repair.
- Update on Station 53 remodel...waiting for Gila County to approve their contribution.
- Update on Station 51 retaining wall...Work will start on Jan. 30 and should be completed by Feb. 20 barring weather delays.
- New SCBA's from AFG Grant arrived on Dec. 2 and are currently being inventoried.
- Chief Lockhart is currently working with the Tonto Apache Tribe on a Gaming Grant... The application requests \$15,000 in equipment.
- Structure fire on Columbine Rd. on Dec. 26...fortunately minimum damage to the structure.
- Sean Minniss while working with Hellsgate Fire Department was working on the Dec. 26 fire on Columbine was injured. We wish him a speedy recovery. This injury will be covered through Hellsgate Workman's Comp.
- Steve McKinnon had surgery on Jan. 6. He is currently in physical therapy. We wish him a successful recovery.
- Board members and staff attended the AFDA Winter Conference in Laughlin, NV Jan. 11 – Jan 13. Classes were very informative and met the statutory obligations of both reelected Board members.
- Karen Thornton reminded the Chief that at the December meeting Joanie Price requested that future incident reports include general neighborhood or mile marker information.

C. Chairman's Report & District Correspondence

Chairman, Ron Kotnik brought up the issue of Christopher Creek rising as snow melt begins. This often makes the crossing (known as The Car Wash) unsafe. In the past CKFD has placed cones to discourage drivers from using the crossing when it is unsafe. The cones are not an effective barrier. Since this is a community effort perhaps it can be explored with Christopher Creek HOA, The Firebelles, and CKFD.


