- CKFD went to Whispering Hope Ranch on June 8 for Firefighters' Day. The guys spent several hours with the children. Whispering Hope Ranch has two more events scheduled with CKFD this summer on June 27 and July 4.

5. Discussion on projected Wildland Income for 2023-2024.

During the past fiscal year CKFD billed \$129,000 for Wildland participation. Of that \$129,000 we cleared \$50,000. The Chief hopes to earn the same Wildland income this year. However, we have limited personnel (one engine boss), which affects our participation. So far this year there have been few calls for help. That should change as the summer progresses. Within three years our income from Wildland funds may become more critical to the department. Jim Oliver asked if the Forest Service might change the current policy toward privatizing wildland staffing. Chief Lockhart responded that there is no indication of that at this time. Rhett Connolly mentioned that early requests for Wildland support in California do not indicate any imminent change.




