B. Chief's Report

Chief Lockhart discussed Department activity for August. The list below highlights this month's Chief's Report (not in any particular order):

- The August 19th deadline had passed for candidate applications for the November 3rd election. Of the three openings, two incumbents remain for another term and one was replaced by Ms. Karen Thornton.
- The new CKFD website was published on September 4th and went live on September 5th after switching from Go Daddy to Square Space.
- CKFD's email was down from September 4th through September 16th. Chief thanked Rhett and Steve for their assistance getting email functional again and for a job well done on new website.
- The temporary bypass on Colcord Road (FSR 291) for the Bridge over Gordon Creek will take place September 17-26. Engineers certified that CKFD emergency vehicles can traverse via bypass.
- The District has received a check in August from Fire Recovery for a little less than \$500.00. Chief added that collecting monies is a bit slow, but we are at a 100% collection rate, so far.

All Board members received a handout, <u>2021 Winter Conference Announcement</u> in their packets. Acting Chairman, Steve, with Chief's help, made clear what two incumbents and new Board member can do to meet Statutory training requirements.
